Emergency Coordination Information by Location

5141 California, Suite 250

- Evacuation Assembly: Parking Lot 70 (at the south-east corner of Bison and California)
- UCI Evacuation Zone: UCI-001A20

111 Theory, Suite 200

- 111 Theory is not part of UCIPD’s jurisdiction or Emergency Management zones; the City of Irvine is responsible for emergencies at this location and authorities will coordinate with UCI as needed
- Dialing 911 from 111 Theory will connect with the Irvine Police Department dispatch center
- City of Irvine Zone: Research Park 25

Newkirk Alumni Center

- 450 Newkirk Alumni Center
- Evacuation Assembly: Parking Lot 14 (next to University Drive)
- UCI Evacuation Zone: UCI-001A20

Telephone Outreach Program (TOP)

- Bison Modular
- Evacuation Assembly: Lot 16AE Assembly Area
- UCI Evacuation Zone: UCI-001C5

Health Advancement in Orange (3800 W Chapman Ave #3300, Orange, CA)

- 3800 W Chapman has a full evacuation plan specific to the location, with drills conducted annually
- The 3800 W Chapman building is not part of UCI Health Emergency Management’s jurisdiction; Orange County and the City of Orange are responsible for emergencies at this location and authorities will coordinate with UCI as needed
- Evacuation Information: Follow directions on signs located next to each stairwell and elevator door

If an emergency happens that requires an evacuation, campus personnel will be notified via the following methods:

- **zotALERT** – an emergency alert system that uses cell phone text messaging to quickly notify the UCI community with safety information. You can sign up to receive these emergency message by visiting the [UCI OIT website](#).
- **UCI Emergency Updates Page** – a website that will provide you the most up-to-date information during an emergency and can be access via [Emergency Updates | UCI](#).
- **Social Media** – updates regarding the emergency will be posted via Twitter ([@ucirvine](#)) and the Facebook ([University of California, Irvine - Home | Facebook](#))
- **AlertOC** is a mass notification system designed to keep Orange County, California residents and businesses informed of emergencies that may require immediate lifesaving actions. By registering with AlertOC, time-sensitive voice messages from the County or City in which you live or work may be sent to your home, cell, or business phone. Text messages may also be sent to cell phones. AlertOC can send out messages to email accounts and TTY devices as well. AlertOC is run by the County of Orange in collaboration with local cities.
